Agreement Between

The City of Copenhagen of the Kingdom of Denmark And the City of Beijing of the People's Republic of China on the Establishment of Friendship-City Relationship

The City of Copenhagen of the Kingdom of Denmark and the City of Beijing of the People's Republic of China, both being the capital cities of their nations, acting in accordance with the principles of the Establishment of Diplomatic Relations between the Kingdom of Denmark and the People's Republic of China, wishing to enhance mutual understanding and friendship between the Danish and Chinese peoples, forge a comprehensive strategic partnership between Denmark and China, and consolidate and develop friendly, practical and mutually beneficial cooperation between the two cities, have reached agreement, through friendly consultations, on the establishment of friendship-city relations.

That agreement is that:

- 1. The two sides will carry out, in accordance with the principles of equality and mutual benefit, exchanges and cooperation in various forms in the fields of economy and trade, science and technology, culture, tourism, education, sustainable development, environmental protection, green transportation and so on, to promote common prosperity and development. Sub-agreements related to these areas of mutual interest will be developed jointly as appropriate.
- 2. Regular contacts shall be maintained between the leaders and relevant departments of the two sides to facilitate consultations on the exchanges and cooperation as well as matters of common concern.
- 3. This Agreement shall enter into force on the date of its signature and shall remain valid for 5 years. The Agreement would retain its force from the date of expiration, should neither side claim termination.
- 4. Signed on 26th June, 2012 in Beijing, the Agreement is done in duplicate in English and Chinese, with both texts being equally authentic.
