

Collaborative Music Show - part II

This is the second part of the project and with it we want to bring the show to different playgrounds in the city and improve materials and methodologies to build a more effective interplay between the musicians and the audience

Where and when

We believe that Collaborative Music Show has to take place in the city's playgrounds where families of different ethnic groups usually spend time together to strengthen the sense of a multicultural community interacting for collective enrichment.
