

eReolen Global: how to get started

Step 1:

To use our services and content for free, you must be a resident at the municipality of Copenhagen, have a Danish CPR number and be registered as a patron at The Copenhagen Libraries.

Find information on how to register on our website bibliotek.kk.dk/opretbruger.

Step 2:

Go to ereolenglobal.dk/.

Step 3:

Sign in at the top right corner. Choose "København" in the dropdown list and sign in with your CPR number and pincode.

Step 4:

You are now ready to use the content.

Tip:

During search: Choose "Advanced" to narrow to Ukrainian books only.

Get the "Libby" app for eReolen Global

Step 1:

Depending on your device install the Libby app from either App store (iOS) or Google Play (Android).

Step 2:

Choose the following in the prompts.

Yes I have a library card

Then search for your library "ereolen global"

Select "sign in with my card"

Sign in using CPR number and pincode

Step 3:

Browse your library's catalog and borrow a title.

Step 4:

Borrowed titles appear on your Shelf (📖) and will download to the app automatically.

In settings you can also search and choose other languages e.g Russian or German.
