



# Avoid rats at the construction site

- Take measures to prevent rats from building nests under the site huts. All huts should be raised 30 cm or higher above the ground.
- Keep the site tidy.
- Dispose of kitchen waste and other organic material from the site huts into a closed container.
- Stack building material in such a way that rats cannot move in and build nests.
- Never leave a sewage pipe open – not during lunch, a smoking break or when you go home. The rats will find the opening immediately and may spread to the surrounding area.
- Make sure that sewer connections from the site huts are made correctly. A rat only needs 2 cm to get through.
- Make sure that any waste pipes are suspended at least 1½ metres above the bottom of the sewer gully.

## Facts on rats

Rats can transmit serious diseases to humans, such as leptospirosis, which can be fatal

A rat couple can multiply to several hundreds within the span of a year.

Brown rats consume all types of organic material, around 25 grams per day
