**NORDISK MEDICINSK HISTORISK KONGRES 22.-25. MAJ 2019  
FOR AT FREMME SAMARBEDJET ML. SKANDIVISKE LANDE**

Dansk Medicinsk Historisk Selskab (DMHS) blev oprettet i 1917. DMHS har i alle årene fremmet forskning inden for den danske og nordiske medicinhistorie, og selskabet har stabilt siden 1972 udgivet en *Dansk Medicinhistorisk Årbog*. Medicinsk historie var, er og bliver afgørende for at forstå fremtidige fremskridt.

2017 markerede en enestående milepæl inden for nordisk medicinhistorie, da der i juni afholdtes 26. Nordisk Medicinsk Historisk Kongres i Uppsala, mens DMHS den 4. november fejrede sit 100-års jubilæum. Bestyrelsen arrangerede et særdeles succesfuldt dagssymposium med parallelle mundtlige oplæg, hvor emnerne relaterede sig til betydningsfulde tidligere bestyrelsesmedlemmer og deres medicinhistoriske meritter. Et totalt deltagerantal på 157 personer, hvor der deltog gæster fra flere nordiske lande, overgik enhver forventning.

De nordiske medicinhistoriske kongresser har været afholdt hvert andet år lige siden 1967 på skift mellem de fem nordiske lande. De udgør et både vigtigt og velbesøgt forum for præsentation og formidling af medicinens historie i Norden. 27. Nordisk Medicinsk Historisk Kongres vil udspille sig fra 22.-25. maj 2019 i DGI-Byen i København, hvor DMHS er arrangør og undertegnede agerer vært.

DMHS har allerede fået bevilget flot fondsstøtte i form af 20.000 DKK fra LEO Pharma samt 100.000 DKK fra Cand. Pharm. Povl M. Assens Fond. Vi tillader os at ansøge **Direktør Michael Hermann Nielsens Mindelegat** om **33.000 DKK** til konkret at kunne tilbyde seks nordiske talenter inden for medicinens historie betalt deltagelse på kongressen samt et bidrag til transportudgifter (5.500 DKK per person) mod, at de deltager aktivt på kongressen ved at give et mundtligt oplæg eller præsentere en videnskabelig poster. Ansøgninger vil blive bedømt af kongressens videnskabelige komite særskilt.

Der ansøges *ikke* om støtte hos andre fonde til netop dette formål.  
Ethvert bidrag vil blive modtaget med dybeste taknemmelighed.

## ***The History of Signs of Death (A)***

Chair: Jesper Brandt Andersen (DMHS).

Prof. em. Jørgen Lange Thomsen will give a 45 min. presentation about *The Cause of Death in Historical Individuals*. He used his knowledge and expertise to look into the life and death of historical individuals. The inquiry gave him quite a number of surprises: Alcoholism and syphilis are not at all as prevalent as thought of. In his presentation, Thomsen will describe his findings in Alexander the Great, Karen Blixen among others.

In his 45 min. presentation *Buried Alive*, PhD Jan Bondeson will explore medicine, history, and literature of Europe and the US to reveal why fears arose and if they were warranted.

## ***The Art of Medical Moulages (B)***

Prof. Dr. Thomas Schnalke will give a presentation about *Directed Views. Focusing Patients and Diseases in Medical Moulages*.

PhD Eva Åhrén, Director at the Unit for Medical History and Heritage (Hagströmer Library), will lecture about the *Nordic Moulage Collections*.

Head of Collection Ion Meyer, Medical Museion, will give a talk about *Preservation...* He has published a number of articles in Danish and international magazines and books, especially about conservation and preservations of organic materials.

### ***On the Edge of Orthodox Medicine (E)***

Chair: Ulrik Bak Kirk (DMHS).

PhD Andreas Bank Lodahl will lecture about *Skodsborg Badesanatorium*, which went from so-called parsley castle to the biggest sanatoria in the Nordic countries in the 20<sup>th</sup> century.

MA Ulrik Bak Kirk will give a presentation on *Snogebæk*. Between 1876 and 1927, more than a thousand working class children of Copenhagen, mainly diagnosed with *scrofula*, were sent to therapy in Snogebæk on the Danish island Bornholm in the Baltic Sea. The initiative was closely coordinated between the medical supervisors and the Municipality.

The third presentation is to be confirmed. Our top priority is to establish an early contact with museum curator Morten Skydsgaard.

### ***Donating Brains and Organs: More Than Waste? (F)***

Chair: Malthe Kouassi Bjerregaard (DMHS).

PhD Maria Olejaz Tellerup will lecture about the shift over the past three decades in Denmark from marked opposition to *organ transplantation* to strong support as well as a pattern in the contemporary public attitudes, which can help explain what is central to public acceptability: self-determination.

PhD Thomas Erslev will give a presentation about *the recent history of brain banking and bioethics* in a Danish context.

***Let there be light – and there was light (I)***

Prof. Ian Bearden from Niels Bohr Institute will lecture about *the secrets of light*.

Prof. dr. med. Poul Jenum will give a presentation about *Daylight and Health*.

Chief Physician Benny Vittrup will shed some *Historical Light on the War Against Cancer: Can we win this war and cure cancer?*

***Leprosy Revisited (J)***

Chair: Jesper From (DMHS).

PhD Magnus Vollset will lecture about *Globalizing Leprosy*. He will give an overview of how the transnational circulation of knowledge was organized, the ongoing debates regarding diagnosis, treatments and prevention, and how positions changed over time.

Prof. Jesper Lier Boldsen will give a presentation about an *Ancient DNA study on Medieval Skeletons from Denmark* that showed lesions specific for lepromatous leprosy. Leprosy is one of the oldest recorded and most stigmatizing diseases in human history. These results suggest how studying ancient leprosy locally improves understanding the history globally.

In his presentation, Jesper From will give us highlights from his biography about the *Life Story of Vilhelm Møller-Christensen*, the Danish medical historian and paleopathologist who pioneered and developed the subject of leprosy osteoarcheology and, through this, made major contributions to the understanding of bone deformity in leprosy.


