Noise Pollution

Urbanization has resulted in a rise of noise pollution

Health impacts associated with noise pollution:

- Increased cortisol
- Increased depression and anxiety
- Increased rate for heart problems
- Leads to lower quality sleep

Common from cooling and ventilation systems
