Dear Ladies and Gentlemen, dear friends,

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Ukraine, together with the United24 platform, plans to launch a global "Lights for Ukraine" actions - symbolic turning off of lights/illuminations in landmarks locations around the world (presentation of project is attached).

The goal of the initiative is to draw attention to the situation in Ukraine, in particular to large-scale blackouts caused by massive missile strikes of Russia on the critical energy infrastructure of Ukraine.

For the first time, such an action was already implemented during the "Notes from Ukraine" concert at Carnegie Hall in New York for the centenary of the performance of the Ukrainian "Schedryk" in the USA.

On behalf of the Embassy of Ukraine in Denmark, I would like to address you to support Ukraine and arrange for a few symbolic minutes to turn off the lighting of the iconic building of Copenhagen (at your consideration), or the main city Christmas tree, on one of the days between December 21 and 30, 2022.

We hope for your positive decision and will be grateful for your answer as soon as possible.
