We have read the "Host City Agreement for the UEFA European Football Championship Final Tournament 2020" with great interest, and the City of Copenhagen hereby confirms its strong interest and engagement in being one of the participating host cities of the UEFA EURO 2020 - one of the single most prestigious sport events in the world.

The City of Copenhagen knows from experience that events of this scale are dependent on a complex preparation and organisational strategy. We consider this event as a matter of public interest with national importance.

EURO 2020 is, without doubt, an event which both the general public, the Municipality and Region of Copenhagen along with the city's businesses consider among the most interesting events worldwide to host and make the most of.

We have a bold vision for UEFA EURO 2020 and will ensure that all practicalities are in place and guarantee that our visitors – fans, participating teams, media, broadcast partners, sponsors and the rest of the UEFA family – will enjoy a safe and hassle-free stay in Copenhagen. This will enable our visitors to focus on what really matters – football. Therefore, we promise to make UEFA EURO 2020 in Copenhagen the most well organized UEFA EURO in history.

With non-stop flights from around 140 international destinations, Copenhagen is only a one or two hours flight away from all major European cities. Furthermore Copenhagen Airport is the preferred low cost carrier airport in Scandinavia with more than 20% low cost traffic scheduled services in 2012.

In 2020, we can guarantee that everyone in Copenhagen will be able to reach any relevant point in the city within 20 minutes. Our Metro will take you from the airport to Parken Stadium within 20 minutes, from the Central Station to Parken Stadium within 20 minutes, and from the stadium to your hotel within 20 minutes.


