Description

This concert introduces the acclaimed Trio Bohémo, a dynamic young ensemble recognized internationally for their fresh interpretations and exceptional musicianship. Trio Bohémo consists of Matouš Pěruška (violin), Kristina Vocetková (cello) and Jan Vojtek (piano). They have garnered prestigious awards and special prizes across the world (more in the bio). At this specific concert Trio Bohémo are invited to cooperate with Kateřina Jelínková (viola), a member of Odense Symfoniorkester and together they will present to the audience their native - Czech music.

They will present selected works by Czech composers Josef Suk, Antonín Rejcha, and Bohuslav Martinů, whose music, despite its richness, is not so often performed in Denmark. While Danish audiences may already be familiar with composers such as Dvořák and Smetana, this program offers new and engaging perspectives, broadening listeners' experiences of Czech musical culture.

Purpose

The concert aims to enrich and diversify the chamber music scene by bringing an internationally recognized professional ensemble. This event emphasizes the value of sustained international chamber music collaboration. Through this, it fosters cultural dialogue and international musical exchange, positioning Copenhagen as a vibrant hub for professional, world-class chamber music performances

The event is targeted not only to classical music enthusiasts, but listeners of all ages, who can appreciate the beauty of romantic pieces on the programme. It also appeals to students of the music schools and conservatories and the international community in Copenhagen, encouraging cultural integration and broadening the audience for chamber music in the city.
