



The *Imperfect Atlas* deals with time and its passage on several levels: the spatial changes of a landscape, the recreated wilderness captured in three distinct RGB-separated exposures transposed as one, and historical narratives of both rediscovery and reinvention. The project features photographs taken during many trips to the Northern Cascade Mountain Range, USA. The works reflect on how human interaction with the planet has changed it in the Anthropocene. This reflection takes place through the change in the possibilities of photography, where manual and digital methods are combined to embed the work with both time and craft. The works are composed of three digital photos, where a red, green and then a blue filter are held in front of the lens, after which the three digital files are converted to analog negative to produce an analog produced print. The first color photograph was produced with RGB separation 1861 in the time of the Industrial Revolution.












### Invitation til soloudstilling på Fotografisk Center

Jeg bekræfter hermed, at Fotografisk Center har inviteret kunstner Peter Funch til at præsentere soloudstillingen *The Imperfect Atlas (arbejdstite)* på Fotografisk Center i 2023. Udstillingen vises i perioden den 01. juni – 11. august 2024 med officiel åbning den 31. maj 2024 kl. 17-19.

*The Imperfect Atlas (arbejdstite)* er titlen på den internationalt anerkendte kunstner Peter Funchs researchbaserede projekt *The Imperfect Atlas* (2019). Med projektet ønsker Funch at skabe opmærksomhed om de drastiske ændringer, som de bjerggrige områder nær Seattle gennemgår på grund af menneskets påvirkning af naturen.

Projektet *The Imperfect Atlas* tager udgangspunkt i den antropocæne tidsalder, hvor mennesket har en irreversibel indflydelse på Jordens geologi og økosystemer, og det Funch selv kalder "vores blindhed over for de konsekvenser, vi skaber". Funch indfanger transformationen og afslører overgangen fra billederne, som ses på gamle postkort af landskabet nær Mt. Baker og Mt. Rainier, til i dag, ved at anvende RGB tri-farvet adskillelse. Denne fotografiske teknik blev opfundet omkring den industrielle revolution og blev anvendt til at skabe verdens første farvefotografi. Gennem denne teknik genfanger Funch landskabet på tværs af tre forskellige eksponeringer via røde, grønne og blå filtre, lagt oven på hinanden.

Udstillingen vil også udfolde et omfattende arkiv- og research materiale, bl.a. vintage postkort, avisudklip, kort og satellitbilleder fra regionen, som Funch har indsamlet og anvendt til at lokalisere positionen, hvor de oprindelige postkortbilleder er taget.
