Democracy is deeply rooted in the Nordic countries. We respect fundamental human rights and freedom, and we see ourselves as open-minded, trustful and tolerant. These are Nordic values shared by all Nordic countries and values worth protecting. We need to cast light on the positive values and uphold them through ensuring safe societies where we do not have to fear fellow citizens.

In recent years these values has been challenged by actions and belief that sometimes result in violent actions. Motives are different across individuals, groups, national borders, religious, political, and socio-economic factors and circumstances.

Whatever the reasoning, radical and violence-promoting behaviour directly threaten our cities' safety and ability to be tolerant. These threats against our communities' cohesion and social contracts have sparked a growing interest in mitigating solutions and efforts on all levels. The problem is complex, but we need to act.

Nordic Safe Cities is a city network working to ensure safe, trustful and tolerant cities for all and actively prevent radicalization and violent extremism.

By agreeing to the Nordic Safe Cities Charter, your city will become a member of the Nordic Safe Cities network and commit to work to create a safer city and to build communities with trust, tolerance and resilience. This is an opportunity for your city to work close together with politicians, practitioners and experts in the Nordic cities and international organizations and network to create a safe city.

By agreeing to the Nordic Safe Cities Charter you will get the opportunity to let practitioners from your City, NGOs, youth groups and companies take part in the Nordic Safe Cities program activities in the Nordic Region and engage in local activities. All program activities will strive to boost and aid your cities local initiatives and give you more knowledge, tools and guidelines for ensuring a safe and inclusive city. In the coming years you will get the chance to showcase your city's work in the Nordic Region and internationally.

The Nordic Safe Cities Network is for engagement of policy-makers and practitioners. The network has been initiated by the Nordic Council of Ministers.
