# Key Areas: Immigrants



- Welcomed 16,103 immigrants in 2010.
- Immigrants account for 19% of our workforce and 21% of unemployed Albertans.
- Very-recent immigrants have a higher unemployment rate (10.2%) than established immigrants (6%).


# Key Areas: Immigrant services

### **Aboriginal peoples**



- Calgary's Aboriginal population has grown 75% over the past 10 years.
- Our Aboriginal population is young, average age is 27 vs. 36 average.
- Aboriginal Calgarians have a higher unemployment rate of 7.7%
- Aboriginal Calgarians earn 22% less than average.
