creative spaces With three buildings and 9 very individual creative spaces

With three buildings and 9 very individual creative spaces totalling 2,000m² as well as access to the outdoor micro spaces of Refshaleøen - the combinations are many.

caretaking

We have taken over the caretaking of Teaterøens Anneks and Kasserne and we hope to keep these unique spaces open as a performance/arts facility in Copenhagen after 12 years under the umbrella of Teaterøen.

hybrid formats

meetings, labs and seminars, urban retreats, project research and development, residencies, rehearsals and productions, international collaborations, site specific projects, public presentations, and any hybrid formats you can imagine.

rewilding

former B&W shipyard and its post-industrial and re-emerging urban nature and 17,000m² of a rewilding habitat to connect to and play in, and with innovative and spirited neighbours. ANNEKSET offers a raw, sensitive urban retreat for physical and emotional resuscitation and inspiration for creative scenarios, artistic processes, and experiences in a context where scenarios for the future of this city are also being played out.

re-thinking

We invite you to explore how artistic and performative practice can affect and influence our re-thinking and our re-relationships with the environment, both the natural, the constructed, the social, the cultural, and even the political. Our perspective will be explorative, critical, participatory and most of all - ecological.

kasernen

The massive brick-built building from the 1920s was, as the name suggests, a naval barracks where officers lived, worked out in the gym and manned the historic walled ramparts from the 17th, giviing some amazing vierws acrosss the harbour and the Sund towards Sweden.

Now the walled ramparts are covered with ivy, giving us a beautiful garden, uncut meadows and our own quayside.

We are somewhere else. The gym is now a super flexible black box. the lower ground floor are units for artist residencies and on the uppe ground floor, studios which cabn easily be converted into a foyer for public performances.



kasernen theatre

Approved for a public up to 150 persons.

Dressing room / backstage at one end 5m.x8m.

Balcony above the dressing rooms, connects to the hall and the foyer.

Access for public direct from the courtyard or via the foyer/balcony.

Flexible auditorium and set up as required.

The hall has no fixed seating. A number of stage units are available.

Rig in the ceiling for hanging lamps etc. A basic lighting set up can be provided.

Black painted parquet floor

Can be used for rehearsals and productions, performances, concerts, meetings/seminars, film and media presentations, installations.

Electricity: 400V 2 x 32 amp.

kassernen foyer

kasernen / first floor

Multipurpose space and can be used as a foyer for the public before / after performances in the theatre or as a studio.

Direct exist to the East, the garden and the bunker.


It is the front of house area for public performances.

Duet access to the fully equipped kitchen.


Large windows to the East and West and beautiful views to the meadow and the harbour, It has the most beautiful light at sunset.

Can be used for dance and performance training, rehearsals, workshops. productions, meetings/talks, and small-sale performances.

Note: **The Studio**, **Foyer** and **Kitchen** can be used together for workshops/labs/events.

They share a common kitchen and bathroom / shower room on the same floor

They can be used 24/7.

They can only be rented for minimum one week.

Studio size: 15-50m²








refshale anneks the garden anden is surror and clair

century ramparts and clothed in green ivy and a magical, even msytical space, out of time and place. Measuring 15m x 30m it is perfect for meditating, stretching, tai chi, yoga, moving slowly and whispering rather than shouting, imagining rather than doing. But is also perfect for some performanances / installations on a small scale and concerts where surround sounds are minimal. Whatever, you might just want to drink green tea and tend to the herbs.









anneks A&B

Situated in a yard with former historic workshops where riggings, masts and motors were made and repaired and where there is still the clang of metal, coils of rope and sails giving a sense of traditional craft to the place.

And with By & Havn Maritime hosting us, this is the place where the harbour, tugs and floats area few metres away. Both buildings are south facing, giving views across rewilding open spaces and tons of light. Here, the robust spaces and streaming light gives a sense of physicality and energy. In the summer, the protected courtyard yard is used for exercises, daily lunches and also as a very 'informal meeting and hang out space for artists and guests.

In **Annekset A**, the White Annesk and Black Anneks studios on the ground floor and the huge loft on the first floor, offering a commone meeting space.

In **Annekset B**, two self container flats and a studio framing group work, mini labs a perfect base for working on site on Refshaleoen.

Together with Metropolis we host workshops and residencies and collaborate on productions for both natural and cultural landscapes.

So if you are working with choreographed walks, sensorial gatherings, soundscapes, in situ performances, this is where you might start.

Based on a strong partnership with REDA, the development agency for Refshaleøen, who are supportive of creative projects, we can introduce you to the Garden and the Courtyard but also to Bedding, Søndre Hoved and other less known spots.

We have a unique opportunity to create in a 17.000m², transforming ladscape which offers both meta scaled buildings, open spaces and vistas but also many micro spaces and habitats which invite to intimate situations. We are committed to exploring and sensing and interacting with place - with materials. the weather, the sea and also with other inhabitants of these micro habitats.

We are always open for longer term proposals and we prioritize projects which can use our spaces for at least one week. With new rental agreements with REDA and BY & HAVN we are now able book spaces up to 12 months ahead. We are able to offer some spaces for one-off events (e.g. Riggerloft) at shorter notice.

At present (2024/5), we are primarily a research, residency production platform but we are open for public performances and events with companies/projects willing to promote and manage public performances.

RENTAL COSTS

Annekset a non profit organisation and rental costs are based on covering our costs. Rates will depend on the specific space, the period of use/rental and the specific project.

STUDIOS (5): DKK 500 - 1.500 per day LOFT: DKK 500 - 2.500 per day THEATRE: DKK.1.500 - 5.000 per day INDVIDUAL ARTISTS STUDIOS (6): DKK:1.000 per week

We prioritize weekends, working weeks and full weeks.
