As a Copenhagen-based international theatre brand, we focus on innovative and contem-porary English-language theatre projects, while creating cultural ties between the regions of Copenhagen, Malmö, Hamburg and London. Artistically our niche at HIT International Theatre Arts is to present highly original, international playwrighting previously unseen in Denmark on socially and politically relevant themes.

With our 5th project presented at Teatret ved Sorte Hest over the last 4 years, we continue our mission to provide on a regular basis, new relevant and cutting-edge theatre for international and Danish audiences, theatre that uniquely reflects the region and has sociopolitical relevance.

As a German actress living in Copenhagen and also beeing a former New Yorker, this project is the yet most personal one for me to stage in Copenhagen. With five performers, music, and an atmosphere of velvet and danger, BERLIN BERLIN invites the audience into the heart of 1930s Berlin – a city ablaze with art, gender liberation, cabaret, and political chaos and asks: *What happens when we ignore the warning signs of our time?* Confronting the rise of extremism, censorship, and social silence is linking the past directly to today's growing polarization, hate speech, and democratic erosion. The audience is invited not just to observe, but to feel the warning: What if history is not behind us – but repeating itself in disguise?

We perform in Copenhagen (Teatret ved Sorte Hest), Hamburg (The English Theatre of Hamburg), Malmö (Bastionen Teaterhus) and - coming in winter 2025/26 - in London.


