My name is Morten Kirkskov, I am the artistic director of the Royal Danish Theater in Copenhagen, Denmark. As well as heading up the theatre, I am an accomplished actor, novelist and teacher. I have only recently met Jens Bjornkjaer as he was hired by the theater to compose the music for the new work 'Horison-ten' which includes a cast of 22 performers (ballet dancers, opera singers, physical and contemporary performers and actors). 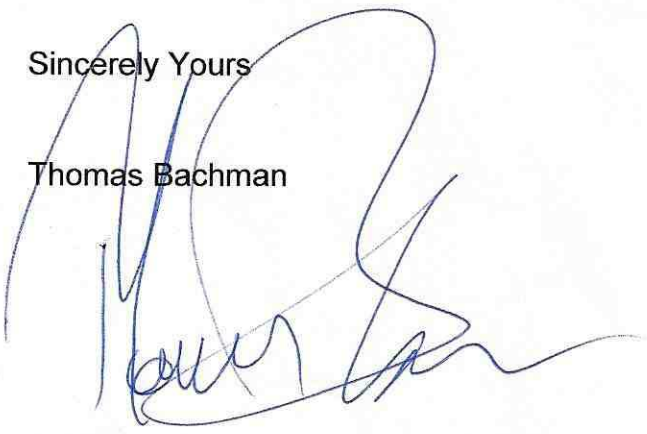
