## Projektbeskrivelse "FROZEN" v/ Daniela Stoian 17.11.2023 – 27.1.2024

The exhibition wants to promote contemplation and open discussion about the physical and psychological effects of climate change. The chosen name, Frozen, indicates both the winter theme of the pictures, a beautiful landscape that in Denmark and around the world we can clearly see changing, and a state of anxiety about the future and the constant feeling of not doing enough for this cause in the present.

More than the images I will gather and provide data to the visitors about the local and global changes of frost days to get a better idea to support discussion.

My work as art workshop facilitator in international youth-camps, with the theme of Stop Climate Changes, has made this reality more vivid, and my need to contribute to the conversation stronger. I have seen many polar bears and dead fish next to plastic bags painted by children that are going to experience the worst of our lack of action.

For me, even in the sight of the most beautiful peaceful snow landscape, the global reality and the anxiety are present, and this exhibition is an opportunity to share our thoughts on that.

The photographs were taken in the winters of 2020 and 2021, and some are taken in Copenhagen. In the winter of 2022-23 there has been almost no snow in Copenhagen, and that confirmed for me the importance of realizing this exhibition.

Galleri Wärme is a small exhibition venue close to the center of Copenhagen, started in 2017 by 2 musicians Marie Wärme & Bo Otterstrøm. As gallerists, they are exhibiting local and international artists that they have met or collaborated artistically with in the past, offering a chance of promotion. As an artist I admire their work and have helped their gallery project in the past, by designing their logo and postcards.

The friendly commission only (barely) covers the rent and utilities of the gallery space. Opening times are Friday 14-17 & Saturday 12-16 and by appointment.

The public of the gallery is diverse as age and nationality. There will be both postcards placed in public spaces, posters, and online promotions. Moreover, I have made an agreement that, as an artist, I will invite visitors from my acquaintance circles and organize small events in the opening hours, like Dj sets and talks. The exhibition will become a place of stories and conversations around the themes. The promotion will be continuous through the 3 months with pictures from all the events on social media, to reach a larger audience.
