Official Invitation to Participate in East Meets North Exhibition Series

On behalf of nProjekt, I am delighted to invite you to participate as one of the two featured artists in our forthcoming exhibition series, *East Meets North*. Your distinctive practice and contribution to the contemporary art scene in Denmark have greatly impressed our curatorial team, and we are pleased to include your work in this cross-regional initiative.

East Meets North comprises two exhibitions to be held in November 2026, featuring two East Asian artists based respectively in Denmark and Finland–originally from Japan and Korea–presented in dialogue with two groups of Hong Kong artists. Together, the exhibitions aim to foster meaningful exchange across cultures and disciplines.

As an extension of nProjekt's Non-Local / Non-Solo framework, *East Meets North* represents a new chapter in our ongoing curatorial exploration. The initiative builds on Non-Solo—which introduced Hong Kong artists to international audiences—and its expansion through Non-Local, which brought media artists from Helsinki, Barcelona, and Buenos Aires to Hong Kong. This edition turns our attention towards the North: a region less frequently represented yet deeply resonant for Hong Kong audiences.

Through the perspectives of two East Asian artists living and working in the Nordic countries, the exhibition considers how artistic practices evolve within Northern Europe's cultural and social contexts. It further explores how East Asian sensibilities intersect with the creative landscape of the region, extending the Non-Local dialogue into new geographic and conceptual territories.

Launched in 2021 during the pandemic as a platform for local artistic production, Non-Solo has since evolved into a model for international collaboration with artist-run spaces. Under the Non-Local / Non-Solo umbrella, artists from Barcelona, Buenos Aires, and Helsinki were featured in Hong Kong in 2024 and 2025.

Your residency in Hong Kong is scheduled for 9-30 November 2026. The first half of the residency will focus on exhibition preparation and development, followed by the opening in mid-November. The latter half will centre on networking, public engagement, and sharing

sessions. The exhibition venue will be confirmed in early 2026 in consultation with our funding partner.



Dear Toshie,

I hope this message finds you well. My name is Jamsen Law, a curator based in Hong Kong.

I was recently chatting with Monti about the upcoming third edition of our project series Non-Local Non-Solo, and she kindly recommended that I get in touch with you.

A bit of background: the Non-Solo series began in 2021 during the pandemic, initially showcasing local artists in Hong Kong. Since 2024, we've expanded it internationally with the Non-Local Non-Solo editions—bringing artists based in cities like Barcelona, Buenos Aires, and Helsinki to Hong Kong for exhibitions that foster cross-cultural dialogue.

Each edition features two components: a Solo section, which presents a small body of work by a single featured artist (almost like a mini solo exhibition), and a Guest section, which invites three artists to each contribute a single work in response to the main artist's themes, materials, or approach. It's a format that encourages conversation and opens up new readings of the featured practice.

Looking ahead to November 2026, I'm planning to curate an edition of Non-Local Non-Solo that brings two Asian artists based in the Nordic region. I'm already in conversation with a painter for one of the Solo sections, which may lean into performance-based or participatory practices for the local Guest responses. I would be delighted to see whether you might be interested in being the featured artist for the other Solo section.

You'd be invited to show 3–4 works, which could be in any mediums of your choice, or to develop something new for the Hong Kong context. If you're open to performance or participatory elements, we can certainly explore that, bearing in mind that there may be certain practical or cultural limitations here. Ultimately, I'd love for this to be a conversation shaped around your ideas and preferences.

We'll confirm local Guest artists only after the Solo parts are settled, to keep the process artist-centric and responsive.

If this sounds of interest, I'd be very happy to answer any questions you might have or to chat further over WhatsApp or Signal at your convenience next week.
