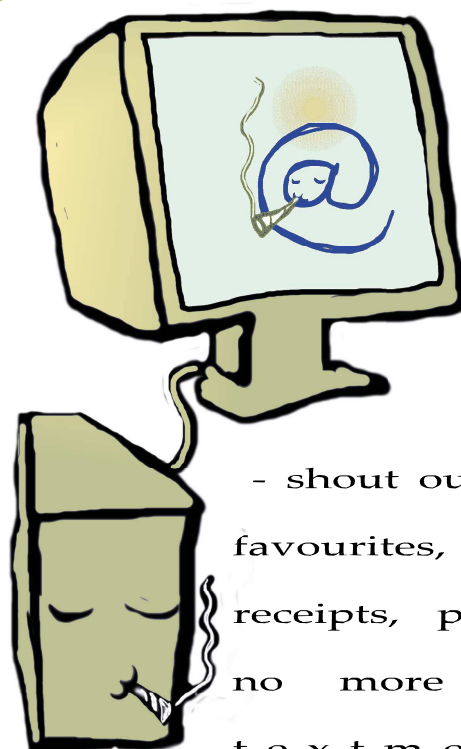

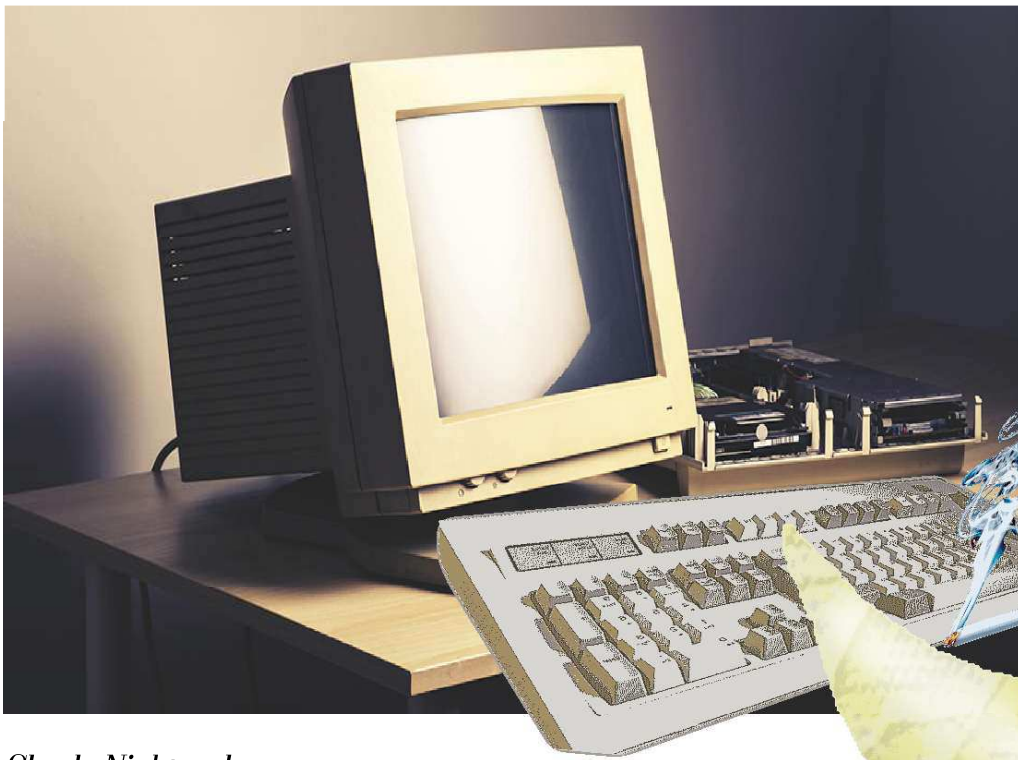

You could have an old piece of fruit manifesting under your butt everytime you try to sit down.

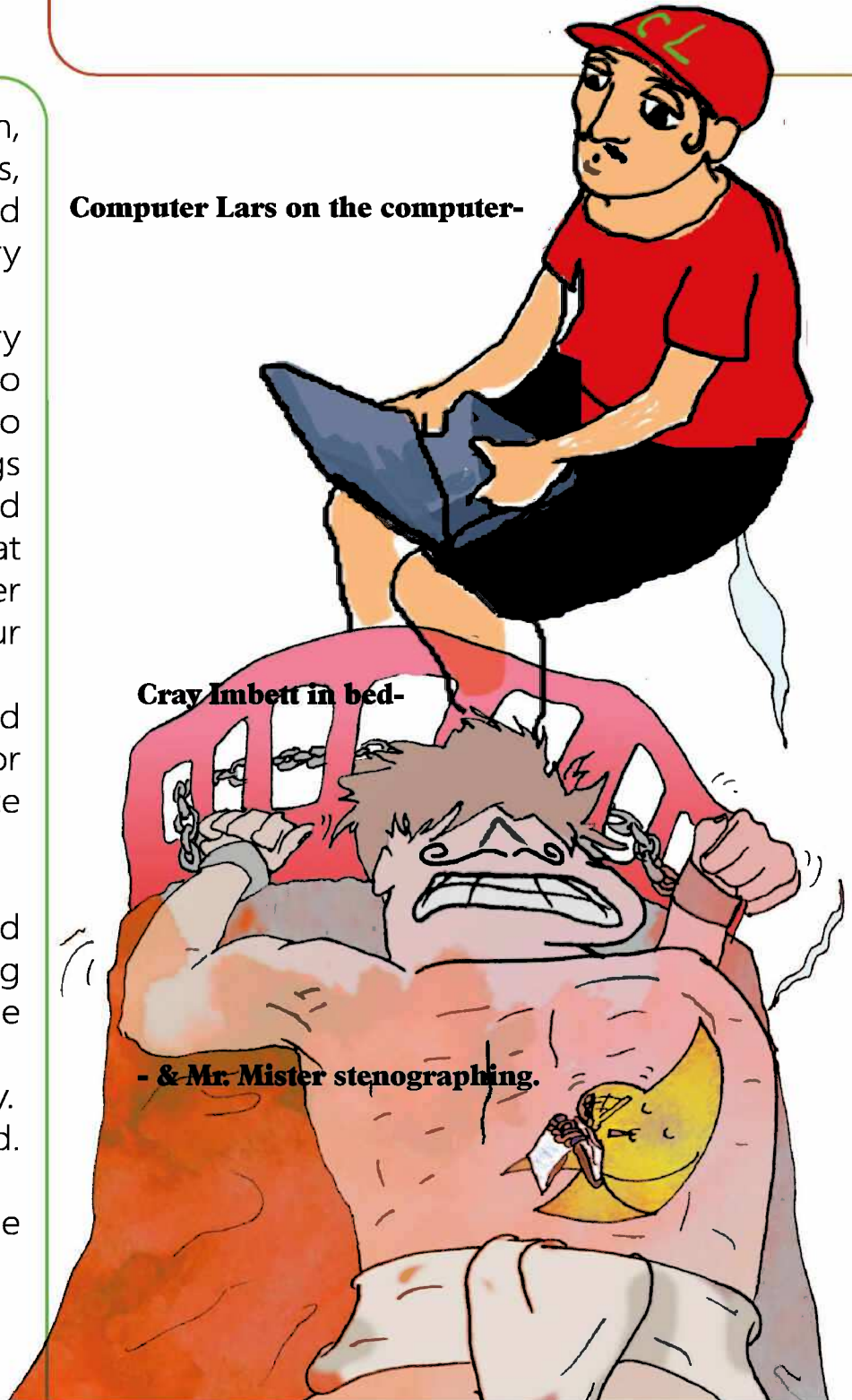
You could be in university. you could be unemployed. You could have a job.

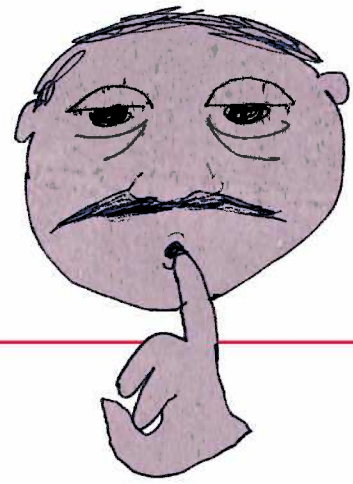
My boss calls me "the computer".
